THEORETICAL KNOWLEDGE EXAMINATION

Effective date: 1st April 2021

Validity Period: PERM

1. This AIC cancels AIC A 14/2020 dated 8th May 2020.

2. BACKGROUND

Historically the SACAA provided theoretical knowledge examinations required for the issuance of aviation licenses on behalf of the NCAA. On the 8th May 2020 the NCAA issued an AIC A 14/20, informing the aviation industry that it was now administering Theoretical Knowledge Examination in Namibia on a full-time basis.

3. REASON FOR ISSUE/PURPOSE

This Notice is intended to inform the Namibian aviation sector and the general public that the NCAA is in the process of amending all documentation including NAMCATS 61, 64 and 66 pertaining to the provision of theoretical knowledge examinations by the SACAA on behalf of the NCAA. We expect this process to be completed by 31st March 2021. As from the 1st of April 2021 the NCAA will no longer accept examinations written under the SACAA for the obtainment of Namibian Aviation Licenses.

4. STATUS OF ALREADY EXISTING EXAMINATION PASSES

Candidates who have already written exams administered by the SACAA on behalf of the NCAA will be credited with the passes already obtained, any other outstanding exams will have to be written at the NCAA Exam Center. No examinations pass apart from that obtained in an examination administered by the NCAA will be accepted after the effective date of this AIC.

5. CONVERSION OR VALIDATION OF SACAA LICENCES

Candidates holding SACAA Licenses who want to convert or validate their Licenses will have to comply with the theoretical knowledge requirements stated in NAMCATS Part 61.
