**AVIATION NOTICE (AMENDMENT):**

**DETERMINATIONS on OPERATIONS of AERODROMES NOT CATEGORISED  
AS A, B, or C in PART 139 of the NAMCARS (2018)**

- 1.1 Aviation Notice AGA/001/2020 dated 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020 ("the original notice") is hereby amended pursuant to regulation Part 3.04.5 to the extent set out in the Schedule.
- 1.2 Paragraph 1.2 of the original notice is amended accordingly.

**SCHEDULE**

**The Determinations set out in the original notice is hereby amended as follows:**

- 1. By the **insertion** under paragraph 2 (Purpose) of the following paragraph:  
  
 " The purpose of the determinations is to provide for the interim period, the operational directives for the safe and secure operation of aerodromes in Namibia that are **excluded from either Category A, B or C** as described in Part 139 of the NAMCARs, 2001, as amended (published as Government Notice No. 293/2018 in Government Gazette 6753 dated 8<sup>th</sup> November 2018)".

2. By the **deletion** of sub-paragraphs 6.1 and 6.2 in the original notice.
3. By the **insertion** under Paragraph 6 of the original notice for the following **additional** determinations:

**“Paragraph 6: Application”**

- 6.1 All aerodromes excluded from category A, B or C which accepted commercial operations as at 30<sup>th</sup> May 2020, may continue to do so until 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021.
- 6.2 Aerodrome operators who have submitted registration form FSS-AGA-FORM-035 by 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020, have 90 days from the date of this (amendment) Notice to submit FSS-AGA-FORM-035A, for the purpose of updating the NCAA Aerodrome Register.
- 6.3 Aerodrome operators who have not submitted FSS-AGA-FORM-035 or FSS-AGA-FORM-035A, have 90 days from the issuing date of this (amendment) Notice to submit FSS-AGA-FORM-035A to be registered onto the NCAA Aerodrome Register.
- 6.4 After expiry of the 90 day period referred to in 6.2 and 6.3 above, the NCAA will avail the aerodrome register for information in a manner contemplated by section 52 (4) read with subsection (5) of the Act. In the event that an aerodrome frequented does not appear on the aerodrome register, aerodrome operators must notify NCAA (AGA) by email ([sos.aga@ncaa.com.na](mailto:sos.aga@ncaa.com.na)) for the correction of a bona fide error in accordance with section 45 (1) read with subsection (2) (c) of the Civil Aviation Act, 2016 (Act No. 6 of 2016) .
- 6.5 Aerodrome operators intending to comply with the Operational Requirements referred to in paragraph 5 of the original notice and provisions outlined in NAMCARs, Part 139, Subparts 4 and 5 relating to “Categories D

and E", may take voluntary action in this regard on condition that:

- 6.5.1 90 days from the issue date of this (amendment) Notice submit FSS-AGA-FORM-035A for registration onto the NCAA Aerodrome Register; and
  - 6.5.2 submit an expression of interest for voluntary compliance for either, Category D or E registration.
- 6.6 The form (FSS-AGA-FORM-035A) is available on the NCAA website, NCAA Head Quarters and on request by email "[sos.aga@ncaa.com.na](mailto:sos.aga@ncaa.com.na)".
