NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROMULGATIONS OF NAMIBIAN
CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS, 2001: CIVIL AVIATION ACT, 2016

Pursuant to regulation Part 3.01.3 of the Namibian Civil Aviation Regulations (NAMCARs), 2001, as amended, the Namibia Civil Aviation Authority ('the NCAA'), herewith announces a regulation making process by way of promulgating new Parts of the NAMCARs and, where applicable, related Technical Standards.

Purpose and reasons: The proposed amendments aim to: address matters as set out in the Schedule, that are required or permitted by the Civil Aviation Act, 2016 to be prescribed to give effect to the Act.

Following due consideration and consultation with the NCAA Board, the Executive Director intends to submit the proposed amendments to the Minister of Works and Transport for promulgation under sections 54 —58 of the Civil Aviation Act, 2016, with effect from a date to be determined.

Interested persons or groups are invited to submit written comments on the proposed amendments to the NAMCARs within 30 days of publication of this Notice, in the manner prescribed.
