SUBJECT: NO. EX-ANSSO-2025-04 FROM NAMCAR PART 173.04.5 (1), PURSUANT TO SECTION 46 OF THE CIVIL AVIATION ACT AND NAMCAR PART 3.03.2.

1. Reference is made to your application form dated 09 June 2025 for an extension of the exemption from the provisions of NAMCAR Part 173.04.5 (1).
2. After careful consideration of the facts presented in the request and given compliance with the provisions of Part 5 Section 46(2) (a-d) of the Civil Aviation Act of 2016 (Act No. 6 of 2016), read with the NAMCARs of 2001 (as amended), specifically NAMCARs Part 3.03.4 and Part 173.04.5(1), the extension of the exemption is granted.
3. The extension to the exemption is granted for a period of 180 days, starting from 16th June 2025 to 13th December 2025 for **Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) related Instrument Approaches** and is valid under the following conditions.
 - a) Runway designator must be change if the magnetic variation is more than one degree.
 - b) The exemption is only granted for Hosea Kutako International Airport and Walvis Bay International Airport.
 - c) The Instrument flight procedures to be reviewed and published before the 13th December 2025 taking into account the AIRAC circle.
 - d) The operations must be in terms of the risk assessment submitted and found acceptable.
