SUBJECT: NO. EX-ANSSO-2026-01 FROM THE PROVISIONS OF NAMCAR PART 173.04.5 (1) AND NAMCAR PART 173.02.1 (7) PURSUANT TO SECTION 46 OF THE CIVIL AVIATION ACT AND NAMCAR PART 3.03.2.

1. Reference is made to your application dated 23 January 2026 regarding the request for an exemption from the provisions of NAMCAR Part 173.04.5(1) and NAMCAR Part 173.02.1(7).
2. After careful consideration of the facts presented in your request, and having satisfied myself that the requirements of Section 46(2)(a-d) of the Civil Aviation Act, 2016 (Act No. 6 of 2016), read together with the NAMCARs of 2001 (as amended), NAMCAR Part 3.03.4, NAMCAR Part 173.04.5(1), and NAMCAR Part 173.02.1(7), have been met, the exemption is hereby granted.
3. Exemption is granted for a period of one hundred and eighty (180) days, effective from 26 January 2026 to 25 July 2026, and is valid subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The exemption is granted exclusively for Walvis Bay International Airport.
 - b) The RNP procedure shall be reviewed and published to be effective on or before 25 July 2026, considering the applicable AIRAC cycle.
 - c) Only operators who have conducted and submitted an acceptable risk assessment shall be permitted to utilize the RNP approaches.
 - d) All operations shall be conducted strictly in accordance with the approved risk assessment.
