Issued subject to the following conditions:

Operational Safety Standards: The Air Service must at all times be operated in conformity with at least the minimum safety standards, as contained in the relevant Annexures to the Chicago Convention and in compliance with the applicable International Conventions which have been implemented in the Republic.

Statistical Information: Statistical information regarding the Air Services shall be furnished within 30 days from the date of such request.

Documents carried on board aircraft: In addition to the requirements of the Convention on International Civil Aviation, 1944, and the Civil Aviation Act of Namibia, as amended and the carrying of documents on board aircraft engaged in International Civil Aviation, a copy of the Foreign Operator's Permit shall be available for inspection on each aircraft specified therein on arrival at the first port of entry into the Republic of Namibia and Namibian Civil Aviation Regulations, 2001, as amended.
