

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR DE-REGISTRATION OF AIRCRAFT**

For an aircraft registered in Namibia to be de-registered, submission of the following items must be made:

1. A formal application letter and the official application form (FSS-AIR-FORM004H) for de-registration.
2. Operator's/Owner's copy of the current Certificate of Registration (C of R), must be returned to the Executive Director NCAA or his/her representative (airworthiness unit) where applicable, and if space is provided at the reverse side for such purpose, it shall be duly endorsed on the reverse side in form of owner's agreement of cancellation.
3. Evidence of payment of statutory charges.
4. If the applicant is not the owner or authorized operator, he/she shall produce evidence of right to deregister satisfactory to the Executive Director or his/her representative.

NB: It is advisable that should there be an intention to eventually export the subject aircraft, arrangements should be made for the aircraft and its records to be inspected for determination of its Airworthiness status as at the time of de-registration.
