<p>If the holder in whose name the aircraft is registered –</p> <p>is an individual and the estate of such holder is sequestrated and a trustee has been appointed, the notification referred to in sub regulation (1) shall be accompanied by a copy of the certificate of appointment issued by the Master in terms of the Insolvency Act, 1936 (Act 24 of 1936);</p>			
<p>If the holder in whose name the aircraft is registered -</p> <p>is a company or a close corporation and such holder is liquidated and a liquidator has been appointed, the notification referred to in sub regulation (1) shall be accompanied by a copy of the certificate of appointment issued by the Master in terms of the Companies Act, 1973, or the Close Corporations Act, 1988, as the case may be.</p>
