SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The NCAA reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) The quotation Letter in Section II
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be **180 days** from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) have a valid company Registration Certificate.
- (b) have an original/certified copy valid good Standing Tax Certificate.
- (c) have an original/certified copy valid good Standing Social Security Certificate.
- (d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) have a certificate indicating SME Status (for Bids reserved for SMEs);
- (f) Bank confirmation letter not older than three months

5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to *subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration* for this procurement process.

6. Delivery

Delivery shall be within 14 days after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order.

7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at **NCAA Head Office, Rudolph Hertzog Street, Ground floor, reception area** not later than **28 August 2026 at 11h00**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach **NCAA Head Office, No.12 Rudolph Hertzog Street** by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening

stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Security/Bid Securing

Declaration will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

10. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership

cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

1. BACKGROUND

The Namibia Civil Aviation Authority (NCAA) intends to appoint a service provider with capacity to supply and deliver 25-litre water dispenser refill bottles and empty dispenser bottles, as well as to provide maintenance, servicing, and repair of water dispensers for a period of three years.

2. SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1. Refill and delivery of 25-litre purified water dispenser bottles to the NCAA Head Office, Eros airport office and Hosea Kutako control tower offices on an as-needed basis.
- 2.2. Refill and delivery of 25-litre purified water dispenser bottles to the NCAA airport control towers (Ondangwa, Katima Mulilo, Walvis Bay, and Lüderitz) on an as-needed basis. Preference will be given to service providers that are locally based within the respective towns.
- 2.3. Provide and replace empty 25-litre water dispenser containers on request.
- 2.4. Supply and deliver 330ml and 500ml still bottled water when needed for specific events (For NCAA Head office only)
- 2.5. Maintain, service, repair, and/or replace NCAA water dispensers upon request to ensure they remain in good working condition.
- 2.6. Bidders should indicate prices for year 1 and year 2. Prices will remain fixed during each contract year.
- 2.7. Quantities may change depending on demand. Supply will be on an as-needed basis.

- 2.8. The service provider must respond to dispenser breakdown or maintenance requests within a maximum of 24 hours from the time of notification.
- 2.9. The service provider shall ensure delivery of water within twenty-four (24) hours of receipt of the PO for non-emergency orders, and within two (2) hours for emergency orders.
- 2.10. All invoices must be submitted to the Finance Department with a copy of the signed delivery note.
- 2.11. All deliveries must be accompanied by an original invoice and delivery note stating the official purchase order (PO) number.
- 2.12. Deliveries not complying with the official purchase order will be returned to the service provider at their own cost.
- 2.13. Ensure timely and scheduled delivery of all items and services as per the terms of the contract.
- 2.14. Respond promptly to emergency requests or urgent needs within an agreed time frame
